Could you or someone you know be missing out on Pension Credit?

If you're aged 66 or over you could be eligible for Pension Credit, which tops up pension income and can help with everyday living costs. Even if you own your home or have savings, you might still qualify.

As well as extra money every week to make sure pensioners have a minimum income, people who are entitled to Pension Credit can also get other benefits like:

- · the Winter Fuel Payment;
- help to pay for NHS dental treatment;
- · vouchers for glasses or contact lenses; and
- a free TV licence if they're over 75.

Not everyone who qualifies for Pension Credit is currently claiming it, so lots of people are missing out.
