26.51 Apologies for Absence

26.51.1 Mr David Foulds (DF)

26.52 Declarations of Interest

26.52.1 *There were no declarations of interest.*

26.53 Minutes of Previous Meeting

26.53.1 The minutes of the meeting of 1 June 2026 were approved and signed as correct.

26.54 Matters Arising

26.54.1 *Blocked Drains* – JJ reported that Mr P Wheelan had advised that two gullies outside his property had been cleared by NYC. Agreed to continue monitoring the situation.

Burneston and Kirklington PC's - had responded to the email sent and both had experienced difficulties communicating with NYC and getting any action on issues. MH advised of a new NYC Parish website for reporting all issues but unfortunately it had experienced technical issues. Now expected to go live on 15 July. To be monitored going forward.

Highways Seminars – briefing notes still awaited. To be chased.

Project Gigabit – NP reported that he had investigated. In brief, NYC had granted a contract to the company Quickline, to speed up and install wifi in rural areas. Unfortunately, Quickline was not available in Carthorpe (for technical reasons).

26.55 Finance

26.55.1 *Receipts & Expenditure* - A brief summary of the financial situation was given: £6418.62 total closing balance which was split as follows: £2177.11 in the Current Account (Precept), £1239.09 in CIL Savings Account (to be spent before 15 October 2027) having received £1 in interest and £3002.42 in Precept Savings Account having received £2.42 in interest.

26.55.2 *Village Savings Account* - Total stands at £424.46 having received £1.21 in interest.

26.55.3 *Year End Accounts* – have been receipted by the External Auditors.

26.56 Planning

26.56.1 *26/03092/FUL* – Change of Use of woodland to allow dog walking – Camp Hill – Ms Monks. JJ outlined the application and discussions took place. It was felt that the entrance on the bend may be an issue, but that NYC Highways would take care of that. No objections raised. All in favour of the application.

26.57 Councillor Report

- 26.57.1 DW advised that the future of the old airfield at Linton-On-Ouse would be discussed at a full NYC Meeting on 14 July. The Government would like to see it used to house asylum seekers. A Lifeline Service seminar had been attended. NYC had entered into negotiations with private builders over house building at Sands End and Eastfield, Scarborough.

26.58 Review of Correspondence Received

- 26.58.1 All correspondence had been circulated.

- 26.58.2 *Bedale TC Fireworks* – had approached asking for a suggested £300 donation towards the 2026 Firework Display. No one in favour of the donation. **MH**
NYC Wildfire Prevention Seminar – unfortunately DF was unable to attend but briefing notes had been emailed to all.
NYC Greenhouse Gas Emissions Seminar – was not attended.

NYC Better Bus Survey – to be completed. **JJ**

NYC GDPR/Cllr address disclosure – JJ advised that NYC had redacted all councillor addresses from their website. JJ had opted in. CC and KA decided that they too wished to opt in. Agreed by all that addresses should remain on the Carthorpe PC website. **MH**

26.59 Matters for Discussion

- 26.59.1 *CIL – Burneston School Roof*

JJ reported that he held a meeting with Burneston School to present the roofing quotation. This quote represented a £20k saving vs the approved contractor. Unfortunately, the School had missed the opportunity to apply for 90% funding from the Diocese for this year. Agreed to await contact from the School in the future with regards to a CIL fund donation.

- 26.59.2 *Water Pump*

JJ presented a quotation for a cast iron pump (£330) plus suction kit (£75) plus delivery (£40) totalling £445. He suggested this be paid for by CIL funds and all works be completed by a working party. All agreed. **JJ**

- 26.59.3 *Footpaths*

JJ advised the meeting that there had been no noticeable action taken by NYC despite agreement. To be followed up. **JJ**
