



**26.31 Councillor Report**

- 26.31.1 DW advised that there was an ongoing dispute between NYC and the Mayor over the splitting of Government funds for pothole repairs. Historically the split was 92% to NY + 8% to York city. The Mayor had decided to revise to 90% NY + 10% York, equating to a £20M reduction to the NY budget over 4 years.
- JJ asked DW if Sutton under Whitestonecliffe PC had been dissolved. DW advise that he did not know, but suggested that it may have been amalgamated, like Kirklington, Howgrave & Sutton Howgrave.
- DF asked DW if residents with private cars were soon having to register to visit NYC Recycle Centres? DW advised that he was not aware of any such scheme.
- DW advised that over the summer months a new red lidded recycle bin would be delivered to households and service commenced for glass and tins, removing the need for the blue box for glass.
